- COVID-19-** We will be observing COVID-19 recommended Protocol:

- PT-** Report in PT uniform for both days- Make sure you wear your prescribed NSCC PT Uniform, duty belt with canteen.

 - b. Ensure Canteens are labeled with you First and Last Name
3. **LUNCH**- We will not be collecting money for lunch, please bring your own lunch.
- a. Bring your own drinking vessel (Canteen- make sure its labeled with your full name)
4. **COURSEWORK** - All Cadets are required to turn in *at least* one (1) coursework assignment per drill. A reminder to those Cadets who have successfully completed Recruit Training: your advancement to E-2 will be delayed until you complete the BMR. Please e-mail the Training Officer if you have any questions. **REMEMBER** - assignments are due each drill. You must complete at least two courses per year to remain in the NSCC or the NLCC. See Training Officer for more information.
5. **EXAMS**- Let us know if you are ready for an exam when you report in the morning so we can plan. Exams will be administered at 1400 on Saturday and Sunday.
6. **UNIFORMS**- Let us know of any uniform needs first thing in the morning when you check in so we can plan accordingly. Uniforms will be issued between 1300 and 1530 on Saturday and Sunday.
7. **ENROLLMENT FEES** - The cost of re-enrollment is \$190.00 for both NSCC and NLCC. Please check your ID card and if your ID expires within the next month, you must pay the re-enrollment during the drill this month. If you are coming up on your re-enrollment date, please ensure you coordinate with the Administration Officer.
8. **REPORT CARDS** – Do not forget to bring in a copy of your report cards when you get them for review and possible awards of the Academic Achievement Ribbon. The award of this ribbon has been extended to NLCC Cadet as well.
