1. We are supporting the Commemorative Air Force at the West Houston Airport with their annual open house event. Drill attendance is **MANDATORY** and absences will be counted as unexcused. You are expected to conduct yourself with the dignity and decorum expected of the NSCC/NLCC program.
2. This is PUBLIC EVENT. Cadets MUST remain at their assigned duty stations, unless relieved by the CO or your CPO. Breaks and time to visit the exhibits will be scheduled. Please do NOT leave your station with your parents WITHOUT the CO's permission.
3. **Cadets with an attendance rate of LESS THAN 75% to-date may be dismissed from the program.**

4. It is never too early to start working on your Dress White uniform- Do you have all you need? If not coordinate with your chain of command on what your needs are including, but not limited to- ribbons & flashes.
5. If you are ready for a test, coordinate with the LPO to ensure proper planning to administer test.
6. If you are a member of the Color Guard or you are interested in joining the Color Guard coordinate with LPO to ensure you are included that practice on Sunday Drill.
7. Canteens will be mandatory for all Cadets beginning August 2020. No camelbacks are authorized to be used. We will place an order, and you must bring in \$10 to pay for your canteen. This does not apply to cadets who have already purchased one.
8. **ATTENDANCE** – Starting 01 April, your attendance will be reviewed quarterly instead of annually. NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. This means that you must be at drill at least 1.5 days each drill weekend. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC/NLCC.
9. **COURSEWORK** - All Cadets are required to turn in **at least** one (1) coursework assignment per drill. A reminder to those Cadets who have successfully completed Recruit Training: your advancement to E-2 will be delayed until you complete the BMR. Please e-mail the Training Officer if you have any questions. **REMEMBER** - assignments are due each drill. **You must complete at least two courses per year to remain in the NSCC or the NLCC.** See Training Officer for more information.
10. **INCREASE YOUR KNOWLEDGE** - Find out everything you wanted to know about the U. S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps on the NSCC Online Portal: <http://homeport.seacadets.org/>.
11. **ENROLLMENT FEES** - The cost of re-enrollment is \$190.00 for both NSCC and NLCC. Please check your ID card and if your ID expires within the next month, you must pay the re-enrollment during the drill this month. If you are coming up on your re-enrollment date, please ensure you coordinate with the Administration Officer. **IF YOU ARE SET TO EXPIRE PRIOR TO 01 AUGUST, please plan to renew before the final Drill date in MAY. Your ID cannot expire during summer training time. This would make you ineligible to attend.**
12. **REPORT CARDS** – Do not forget to bring in a copy of your report cards when you get them for review and possible awarding of the Academic Achievement Ribbon. The award of this ribbon has been extended to NLCC Cadet as well.
